

TECLO Outputs: MOOC for Future Textile and Clothing Managers



The TECLO consortium developed a **Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) for Future Textile and Clothing Managers**. It is composed of seven learning units, it is accessible completely online, and it is free.

Enrolling in the TECLO MOOC you will be able to learn on your own schedule watching short video lectures, taking interactive quizzes and connecting with classmates and tutors. The video lectures are available in **English**, with subtitles in eight **languages**: English, Spanish, Greek, French, Italian, Polish, Romanian and Slovene.

The students completing the course will receive a certificate stating the learning outcomes achieved. The TECLO **MOOC for Future Textile and Clothing Managers** will be available from **20th October 2016** to a first class of **maximum 200 students**.
